Teacher Representative, Mrs. Julie Wilson reported that the students liked having two half days to end the year and that the school year ended quietly.

Elementary Principal, Jason Vislosky, reported that the school year ended well with the awards assembly. He explained that the staff worked with the students on behavior expectations before the ceremony and that it makes a huge difference when we're proactive. Mr. Vislosky thanked Keith Roberts and the custodial team for helping getting classrooms ready for new teachers to move into. The classroom for Headstart is ready for them to move into and Red Raider Care will move to the preschool classroom this year. He reported that teacher start times and student drop off times will change to 7:55 am next year. The handbook will be updated this year to align with new legislation. Suggested student supply lists are available on the web page.

Jr/Sr High School Principal Garnett Kohler thanked Anne Wood for all she did for the Jr/Sr High School as well as for giving him her time getting acquainted to Marlette Schools. He also thanked Shari Hirsch and Jane Wildey for their years of service to the Marlette Schools. Mr. Kohler recognized the Girls & Boys Disc Golf Team. They participated in the state competition this year with the girls winning the State Championship. The girls' team consisted of Justine Eveland (winner of the 16U division), Haley Liu (2nd in the 16U Division) and Azreyal McCanham (2nd in the 18U division). The boys' team: Jonathon Holcomb, Sedrik Marchesano and Zachary Herman finished in 4th place. The schools' maintenance and custodial staff is working to prepare the building for the 2017-18 school year. The class schedule is almost complete, with just a few wrinkles to iron out. The summer food program is going strong. 7th and 8th grade orientation will be held on Tuesday, August 29th at 6:00 p.m. The other orientation times will be announced when they are set. Mrs. Behnke and Mr. Shifflett met with Mr. Kohler and discussed the Haiti trip, both felt it was a great and rewarding trip.

Superintendent Barratt reported that the Marlette Police held an "Active Shooter" Training at the Elementary School. The training was attended by Michigan State Troopers, officers from Marlette, Croswell, and Sandusky as well as the Marlette and Burlington Fire Departments and the Marlette and Sanilac EMS. The central office staff will be busy in July preparing for the audit and with vacations coming up she asked that if anyone wants to meet with someone in central office, they call ahead to make sure that they're available.


